John James Bryenton was born April 17, 1945 in the former Town of Newcastle. A lifelong resident of the Miramichi, Jay was a 1963 graduate at Harkins High School and held a Bachelor of Arts degree from St. Thomas University in Fredericton, NB.

Jay began his career with the former Town of Newcastle in 1974. As Facilities Supervisor for the Recreation Department, he managed the operation of “Moon’s Palace”. In subsequent years, he progressed to the position of Assistant Town Superintendent and later as the Assistant Public Works Superintendent with the City of Miramichi.

Jay was an active member of CUPE Local 3863 and held various positions in the Union since its inception in 1996.

In his younger days, Jay played, coached, and umpired the game of baseball. Later his passion for Duplicate Bridge culminated in his achieving Life Master.

Jay will always be remembered by his fellow union members and many friends for his quick wit and sense of fair play. He was a kind and decent human being.
